Your mission, should you choose to accept it, is to attend a planetarium show at the Morehead Planetarium and Science Center. If you do, please:

- (1) Get there early, because shows fill up, especially the Discover your Universe show . It's a bummer to get turned away, but it happens. And you can't get in once they start.
- (2) Show your OneCard at the ticket counter, and tell them you are an Astro 101 student. Astro 101 students can attend all planetarium shows this semester for free!
- (3) Sign the sign-in sheet at the ticket counter. If the planetarium staff are wondering where it is, remind them that the sign-in sheets are on the Astronomy 101 clipboard.

***If you don't sign in, you can't get credit.*** We'll collect the sign-in sheets to sort out who attended.

The Discover your Universe show is particularly good for what you need to know for the course. The next two show s will be:

Friday, 26 Aug, 8:30 p.m. (Yep, that's today!)

Thursday, 6 Oct, 7:30 p.m. (Note the loooong delay from tonight!)

The Carolina Skies shows are also relevant to what you'll learn this semester. They are offered:

Sundays at 3:30 pm (except 11 Sep, when Morehead is closed for maintenance)

Saturdays at 2:30 pm (starting 17 Sep and going through 6 Nov)
